Wisconsin Office of Children's Mental **Health Releases Fact Sheet on Mental Health Impact of School Shootings**

WISCONSIN OFFICE OF CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH

School shootings have a traumatic effect on the entire school community and can cause long-term harm to youth mental health and well-being. Children who survive shootings have twice as many pain disorders, are 68% more likely to have a psychiatric diagnosis, and are 144% as likely to develop a substance use disorder than those who did not experience a shooting.

According to the latest fact sheet from the Wisconsin Office of Children's Mental Health (OCMH), anxiety, depression, and PTSD, along with hypervigilance and fear are common mental health conditions of shooting

'We know from national research that gun violence is top of mind for many students, and some do not feel safe at school. But we also know there are steps we can take to curb school violence," said OCMH director Linda Hall, who frequently hears that students are very concerned and taking action themselves. "We know that students are using SUSO - the Speak Up, Speak Out tip line created by the Wisconsin Office of School Safety to identify bullying and report concerns about weapons or violence. That is great news because a school culture that promotes help seeking over secrecy is critical."

In addition to utilizing the SUSO tipline, OCMH highlights three strategies experts say can help reduce school violence: school belonging, safe storage, and school safety drills. The fact sheet also includes a number of actions that parents, schools, physicians, and policymakers can take.

"We all have a role to play in protecting our children from harm. Parents who own guns can follow the safe

Langlade County ATV Trails

There are four main trails that are connected through various road routes. The newest route to the northern Langlade County ATV/UTV trails is the City of Antigo Route. The route runs from Century Avenue down Saratoga Street to the railroad grade behind Amron by Karl's Transport. The ATV trails in Langlade County are open, weather permitting, after May 1st and close December 1st.

Augustyn Springs Trail is located in the northeastern part of Langlade County. Augustyn Springs Trail is 21 miles in length and owned entirely by Langlade County. The trail is very scenic and is located in a large block of northern hardwoods. It has rolling to very hilly terrain. This trail has some rockiness, and during wet periods has some water holes. This two-way trail travels on old logging roads which are also open to other recreationalists. This trail is in an area containing many other wood trails. There is a parking lot, restrooms, and ATV ramp which is located on Highway A, 8 miles northeast of Neva from Highway 45.

Parrish Highland Trail is located in the northwestern part of Langlade County. This trail system has 50 miles of scenic terrain that traverses glacial moraines, upland hardwoods, cedar swamps and small rivers and lakes. The terrain is rolling to very hilly. This trail links up with the Lincoln and Oneida County ATV trail system. This two-way trail travels on old logging roads which are also open to other recreationalists. There are three parking/access points. They are on Highway Q, at the Oneida/Langlade County Line; Highway H, 2 miles south of Highway 17 and Q; and Highway T, 3 miles west of Highway 45, Summit Lake. The Highway T location has an ATV washing station, restrooms and ATV ramp.

Pickerel/Pearson ATV Trail is located in the northeastern part of Langlade County, between Post Lake and Pickerel. This 5 mile trail connects the Parrish/Highlands ATV trail and the Augustyn Springs ATV trail. The trail runs on either side of Rolling Stone Lake and along the east side of Pickerel Lake through county forest land and over to Upper and Lower Post Lake. Pickerel/Pearson Trail offers picturesque scenery by these lakes, river, and county forest land even though, most of the trail is on roadways.

White Lake Trail is located in the southeastern part of Langlade County by White Lake. This trail is 20 miles. The trail has rolling and hilly terrain through hardwoods. You can park and access the trail around White Lake in two places, Sherry Road, 1.25 miles north of Highway 64, Polar or in downtown White Lake on Highway M and Maple Street. The downtown location has a restroom available.



Cycling/Mountain Biking/Hiking Ackley Wildlife Area

Just west of Antigo is the Ackley Wildlife Area where hikers have great opportunities to view waterfowl, deer, and an occasional bear.

Antigo Single Track Mountain Bike Trail



Location: W6379 Fifth Avenue Road, Bryant, WI 54418. The trail is located entirely on Langlade County property east of Antigo off 5th Avenue Road. Length: 5.5 miles in length and has a variety of trails for all abilities.

Ice Age Trail

Langlade County boasts 50 miles of the thousandmile Ice Age Trail, divided into five segments: 13 miles Kettlebowl, 12 miles Lumbercamp, 9.5 miles Old Railroad, 13.5 miles Highland Lakes and 12 miles Parrish Hills.

Moccasin Lake

The trail oversees two river basins; the Prairie flowing west, and the Hunting flowing east. On the eastern leg the view overlooks a vast black spruce swamp which extends all the way to and beyond Elcho. The far end offers three fun hills; the Luge, the Expressway, and the Muskellunge.

storage guidelines; caregivers can emphasize building empathy and preventing bullying; educators can cultivate inclusive school environments that promote belonging and reduce isolation; pediatricians can embed mental health screenings into their routine practice; and policymakers can fortify school mental health funding, pass a safe storage requirement, and strengthen Wisconsin's child access prevention law," said Hall.

Resources on safe storage, bullying prevention, school safety, school safety drills, behavioral threat assessment, and violence prevention are included in the fact sheet.

"Everyone, no matter their role, can help create a sense of belonging and connectedness for our young people," Hall emphasized. "When we reduce bullying and social isolation, we are doing the important work of supporting the physical and psychological safety needs of our youth."
