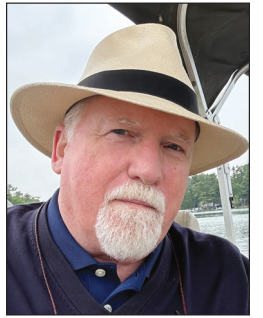

Aspirus Offering Free Seminar on Atrial Fibrillation May is Stroke Awareness Month – Learn about the AFib & Stroke Connection

ASPIRUS HEALTH

Atrial fibrillation (AFib) is estimated to affect over 2.7 million Americans, but many do not even know they have it. If left untreated, the heart rhythm disorder causes the heart to beat irregularly, greatly increasing the risk of stroke and heart failure.

Aspirus Heart Care is offering a free seminar on Thursday, May 9th where people can learn more about atrial fibrillation, its connection to strokes and heart failure, as well as innovative treatment options offered at Aspirus Heart Care.

The seminar is at The Holiday Inn Stevens Point Convention Center and runs from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. It is free to attend, but registration is required.



Aspirus Heart Care Cardiothoracic Surgeon, John Johnkoski, MD, and Electrophysiologist, Kevin Rist, MD, PhD, will provide information about traditional management, minimally invasive surgical procedures, catheter-based ablation, as well as combined approaches that treat atrial fibrillation to help reduce symptoms, prevent strokes,

and allow people to live more active lives.

“The major issues with atrial fibrillation aren’t the symptoms, which are certainly troubling; rather, patients with the condition risk heart failure and stroke,” says Dr. Johnkoski. “The risk of stroke increases about five-fold in individuals with AFib compared to those in normal sinus rhythm.”

“AFib involves abnormalities in the electrical signals within the heart, so prompt diagnosis is crucial,” says Dr. Rist. “Prolonged episodes can lead to changes in the atrial tissue and electrical properties. These changes can perpetuate AFib and make it more challenging to manage.” Managing AFib is essential for reducing the risk of serious complications. It’s important for individuals with AFib to actively participate in their treatment plan and work with their healthcare team to help support symptom free active lives.

Wisconsin Office of Children’s Mental Health Releases Fact Sheet on Mental Health Impact of School Shootings

WISCONSIN OFFICE OF CHILDREN’S MENTAL HEALTH

School shootings have a traumatic effect on the entire school community and can cause long-term harm to youth mental health and well-being. Children who survive shootings have twice as many pain disorders, are 68% more likely to have a psychiatric diagnosis, and are 144% as likely to develop a substance use disorder than those who did not experience a shooting.

According to the latest fact sheet from the Wisconsin Office of Children’s Mental Health (OCMH), anxiety, depression, and PTSD, along with hypervigilance and fear are common mental health conditions of shooting survivors.

“We know from national research that gun violence is top of mind for many students, and some do not feel safe at school. But we also know there are steps we can take to curb school violence,” said OCMH director Linda Hall, who frequently hears that students are very concerned and taking action themselves. “We know that students are using SUSO – the Speak Up, Speak Out tip line created by the Wisconsin Office of School Safety – to identify bullying and report concerns about weapons or violence. That is great news because a school culture that promotes help seeking over secrecy is critical.”

In addition to utilizing the SUSO tipline, OCMH highlights three strategies experts say can help reduce school violence: school belonging, safe storage, and school safety drills. The fact sheet also includes a number of actions that parents, schools, physicians, and policymakers can take.

“We all have a role to play in protecting our children from harm. Parents who own guns can follow the safe

How to donate blood
Simply download the American Red Cross Blood Donor App, visit RedCrossBlood.org, call 1-800-RED

CROSS (1-800-733-2767) or enable the Blood Donor Skill on any Alexa Echo device to make an appointment or for more information. All blood types are needed to ensure a reliable supply for patients. A blood donor card or driver’s license or two other forms of identification are required at check-in.

Individuals who are 17 years of age in most states (16 with parental consent where allowed by state law), weigh at least 110 pounds and are in generally good

health may be eligible to donate blood. High school students and other donors 18 years of age and younger also have to meet certain height and weight

Requirements

Blood and platelet donors can save time at their next donation by using RapidPass® to complete their pre-donation reading and health history questionnaire online, on the day of their donation, before arriving at the blood drive. To get started, follow the instructions at RedCrossBlood.org/RapidPass or use the Blood Donor App.

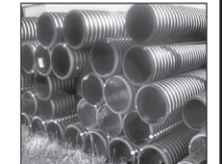

Langlade County ATV Trails

There are four main trails that are connected through various road routes. The newest route to the northern Langlade County ATV/UTV trails is the City of Antigo Route. The route runs from Century Avenue down Saratoga Street to the railroad grade behind Amron by Karl's Transport. **The ATV trails in Langlade County are open, weather permitting, after May 1st and close December 1st.**

Augustyn Springs Trail is located in the northeastern part of Langlade County. Augustyn Springs Trail is 21 miles in length and owned entirely by Langlade County. The trail is very scenic and is located in a large block of northern hardwoods. It has rolling to very hilly terrain. This trail has some rockiness, and during wet periods has some water holes. This two-way trail travels on old logging roads which are also open to other recreationalists. This trail is in an area containing many other wood trails. There is a parking lot, restrooms, and ATV ramp which is located on Highway A, 8 miles northeast of Neva from Highway 45.

Parrish Highland Trail is located in the northwestern part of Langlade County. This trail system has 50 miles of scenic terrain that traverses glacial moraines, upland hardwoods, cedar swamps and small rivers and lakes. The terrain is rolling to very hilly. This trail links up with the Lincoln and Oneida County ATV trail system. This two-way trail travels on old logging roads which are also open to other recreationalists. There are three parking/access points. They are on Highway Q, at the Oneida/Langlade County Line; Highway H, 2 miles south of Highway 17 and Q; and Highway T, 3 miles west of Highway 45, Summit Lake. The Highway T location has an ATV washing station, restrooms and ATV ramp.

Pickerel/Pearson ATV Trail is located in the northeastern part of Langlade County, between Post Lake and Pickerel. This 5 mile trail connects the Parrish/Highlands ATV trail and the Augustyn Springs ATV trail. The trail runs on either side of Rolling Stone Lake and along the east side of Pickerel Lake through county forest land and over to Upper and Lower Post Lake. Pickerel/Pearson Trail offers picturesque scenery by these lakes, river, and county forest land even though, most of the trail is on roadways.

White Lake Trail is located in the southeastern part of Langlade County by White Lake. This trail is 20 miles. The trail has rolling and hilly terrain through hardwoods. You can park and access the trail around White Lake in two places, Sherry Road, 1.25 miles north of Highway 64, Polar or in downtown White Lake on Highway M and Maple Street. The downtown location has a restroom available.

Location: W6379 Fifth Avenue Road, Bryant, WI 54418. The trail is located entirely on Langlade County property east of Antigo off 5th Avenue Road. Length: 5.5 miles in length and has a variety of trails for all abilities.

Ice Age Trail

Langlade County boasts 50 miles of the thousand-mile Ice Age Trail, divided into five segments: 13 miles Kettlebowl, 12 miles Lumbercamp, 9.5 miles Old Railroad, 13.5 miles Highland Lakes and 12 miles Parrish Hills.

Moccasin Lake

The trail oversees two river basins; the Prairie flowing west, and the Hunting flowing east. On the eastern leg the view overlooks a vast black spruce swamp which extends all the way to and beyond Elcho. The far end offers three fun hills; the Luge, the Expressway, and the Muskellunge.

Location: The trail is located entirely on Langlade County property north of Antigo off Moccasin Lake Road. Length: 5.5 miles in length and offers a variety of trails for all abilities.

Nicolet Roche Trail

The challenging Nicolet Roche Mountain Bike Trail, located in the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest, is a single-track trail that incorporates natural features sure to keep the excitement level up.

Location: On the south end at Boulder Lake Campground & Boat Landing 1.8 miles northeast of Hwy 55 via Cty WW and Forest Road 2116. On the north end on Hwy 64, 3.3 miles east of Langlade. Length: 14 miles total with 13 miles of single-track.

Veteran's Memorial Park

storage guidelines; caregivers can emphasize building empathy and preventing bullying; educators can cultivate inclusive school environments that promote belonging and reduce isolation; pediatricians can embed mental health screenings into their routine practice; and policymakers can fortify school mental health funding, pass a safe storage requirement, and strengthen Wisconsin's child access prevention law," said Hall.

Resources on safe storage, bullying prevention, school safety, school safety drills, behavioral threat assessment, and violence prevention are included in the fact sheet.

"Everyone, no matter their role, can help create a sense of belonging and connectedness for our young people," Hall emphasized. "When we reduce bullying and social isolation, we are doing the important work of supporting the physical and psychological safety needs of our youth."




